**THE BASICS**

**MEMORY VERSE**

**1 Corinthians 11:24**, *"Do this to remember Me."*

**BOTTOM LINE:** Communion reminds us of all the things Jesus did for us.

**BIBLE STORY: The Last Supper (Matthew 26:26-30; Mark 14:22-26; Luke 22:15-20; I Corinthians 11:23-25)**

The night before Jesus was crucified, He met with His disciples to celebrate the Passover. While they were eating, Jesus took the bread, broke it and gave it to His disciples to eat. He told them that the bread was a picture of healing for their bodies. He then took the juice and gave it to them. He told them it was a picture of forgiveness and the cleansing of their heart from sin. Jesus began communion. It is a picture of what He has done for us.

**Point to Make:** *COACHES: Do not use the word "blood." Do not talk about "drinking His blood" or "eating His body."*

**MAKE IT REAL**

**Picture:** Photo album, bread, juice

- A photo album holds pictures, and they help us remember our vacations, birthdays, and special events.
- Communion is a time to remember. It is like a picture of what Jesus did for us.
- Jesus did two things when He died on the cross for us.
  1. He healed our bodies, and the bread is a picture of healing.
  2. He cleansed our heart, and the juice is a picture of forgiveness.
- God, the Holy Spirit, fills us and works through us today.

1. What is communion? *(A time to remember; a picture of what He has done for us.)*
2. What are the two things that Jesus did for us? *(He cleaned our heart and He healed our bodies)*
3. What is the bread a picture of? *(Healing)*
4. What is the juice a picture of? *(Forgiveness)*
