


# God Made the Heavens

Dear Parent,

Thank you for giving us the opportunity to teach your child. Today we start learning from the Bible about the things God created for us. We learned that when God made the heavens, He placed them way up high. We also learned that on certain days we can see clouds way up high in the sky. We can have happy hearts when we know God's Word, because it tells us that God created the Heavens.

**Goal:**

Each child should know the Bible tells us that God created our wonderful world and the things in it because He loves us.

**Scripture:**

Jeremiah 15:16, "God's Word makes my heart rejoice."

**Song:**

*The Blue Sky, sung to the tune of **Mary Had a Little Lamb***

**Activity Suggestion at Home:**

Allow your child to touch and squeeze white pillow stuffing and imagine how soft the clouds must feel. On a sunny day, go for a walk and observe the clouds in the sky. Do stretching exercises with your child as you sing, *The Blue Sky*. Start out with your hands to the ground and gradually raise them until you get to the phrase "way up high." Stretch as high as you can, stepping up on your tippy toes. When you get to the phrase, "Clouds were hung up in the sky," use hand motions to hang clouds.

Young children learn through simplicity and repetition. For this reason, we have provided you with the picture on the reverse side of this paper and the words to today's song. We encourage you to use the Bible verse, song, and the picture as a daily reminder of the lesson taught today.
