


God Made Flowers Grow

Dear Parent:

Activity Suggestion at Home:

Allow your child to help you water your plants around the home with an eye dropper filled with water. Refer to silk flower or plant arrangements, letting the child know that man thought flowers and plants were so beautiful that someone made ones that look just like the real ones. Talk with your child about how beautiful God made the flowers for us to enjoy. If the season permits, plan a walk that allows time to see all the different kinds of plants God created. Stop to smell flowers if you find them.
