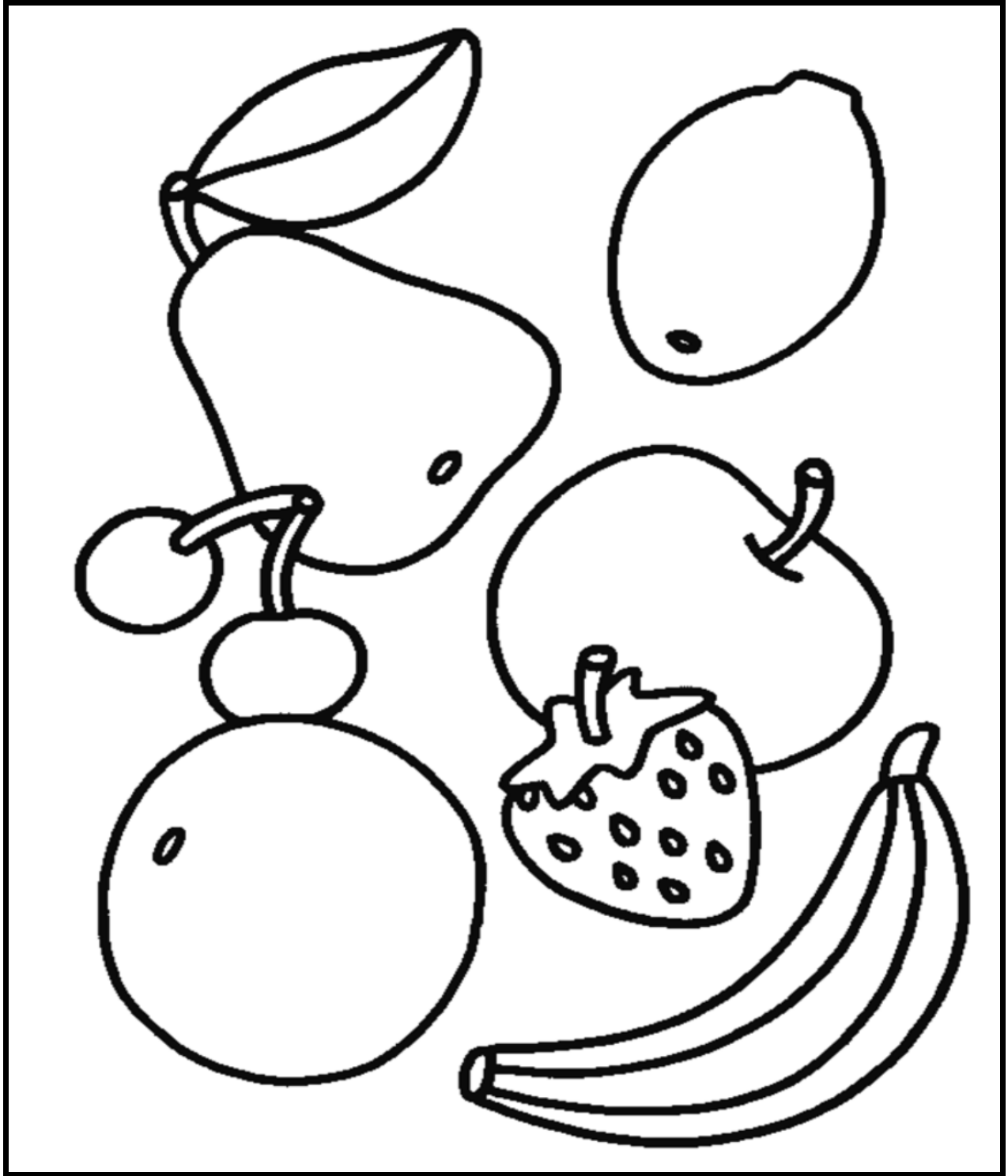


God Made Food to Grow

Activity Suggestion at Home:

If it is the season for gardening, allow the child to visit your garden or a friend's garden to see the items growing.
