Goal:

Activity Suggestion at Home:

Look through magazines and books to find and talk about pictures of people doing things to get ready for bedtime. While playing lullaby music help your child prepare a baby doll for bedtime by giving it a bath, putting on pajamas and reading it a story. This is also a great time to establish a nighttime routine. Talk to your child about how God desires for our bodies to get the rest it needs, and He provided nighttime just for that! When you are outside at night, take a moment to look at the moon and stars.

Young children learn through simplicity and repetition. For this reason, we have provided you with the picture on the reverse side of this paper and the words to today's song. We encourage you to use the Bible verse, song and the picture as a daily reminder of the lesson taught today.
