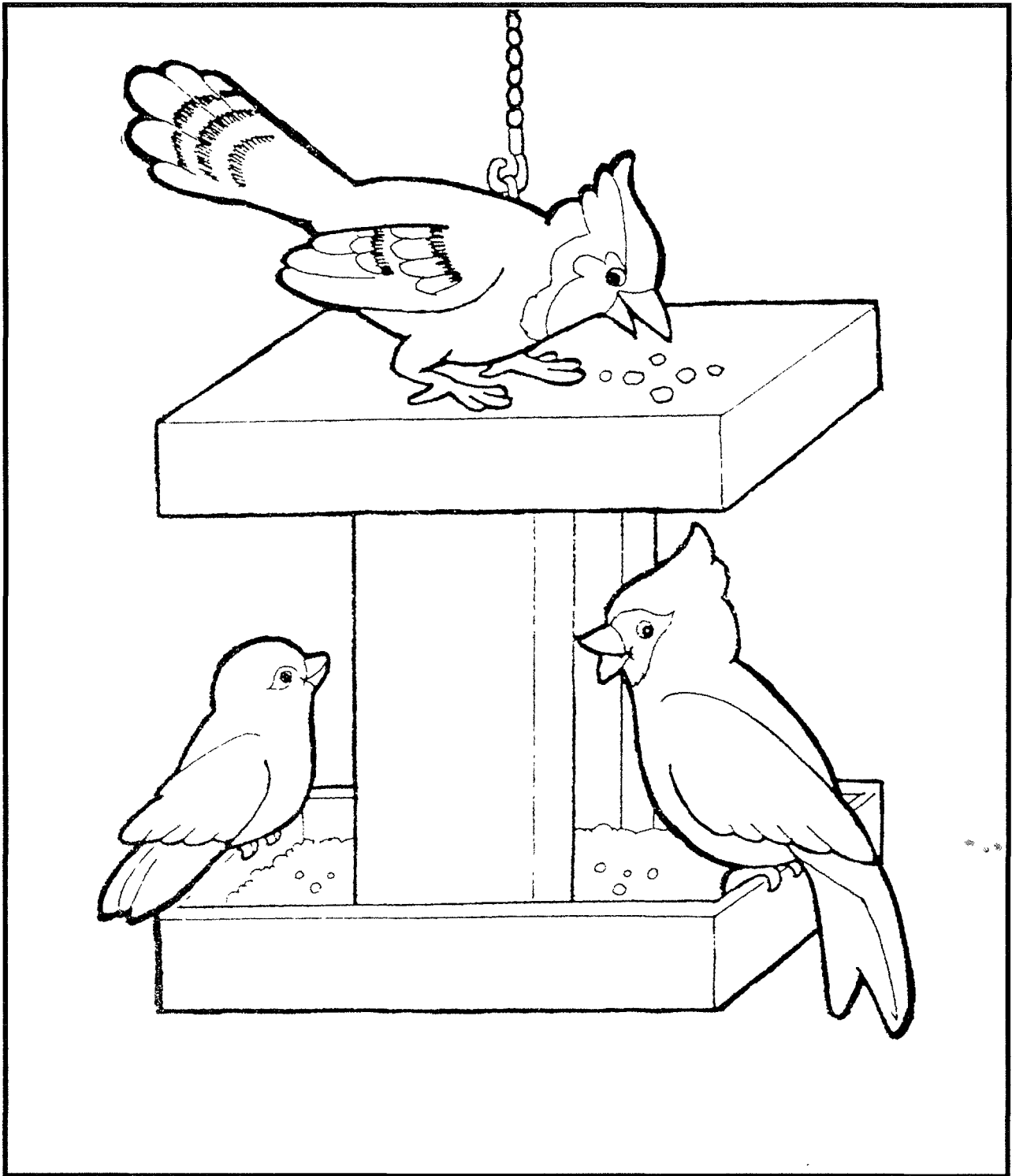


God Made Birds
