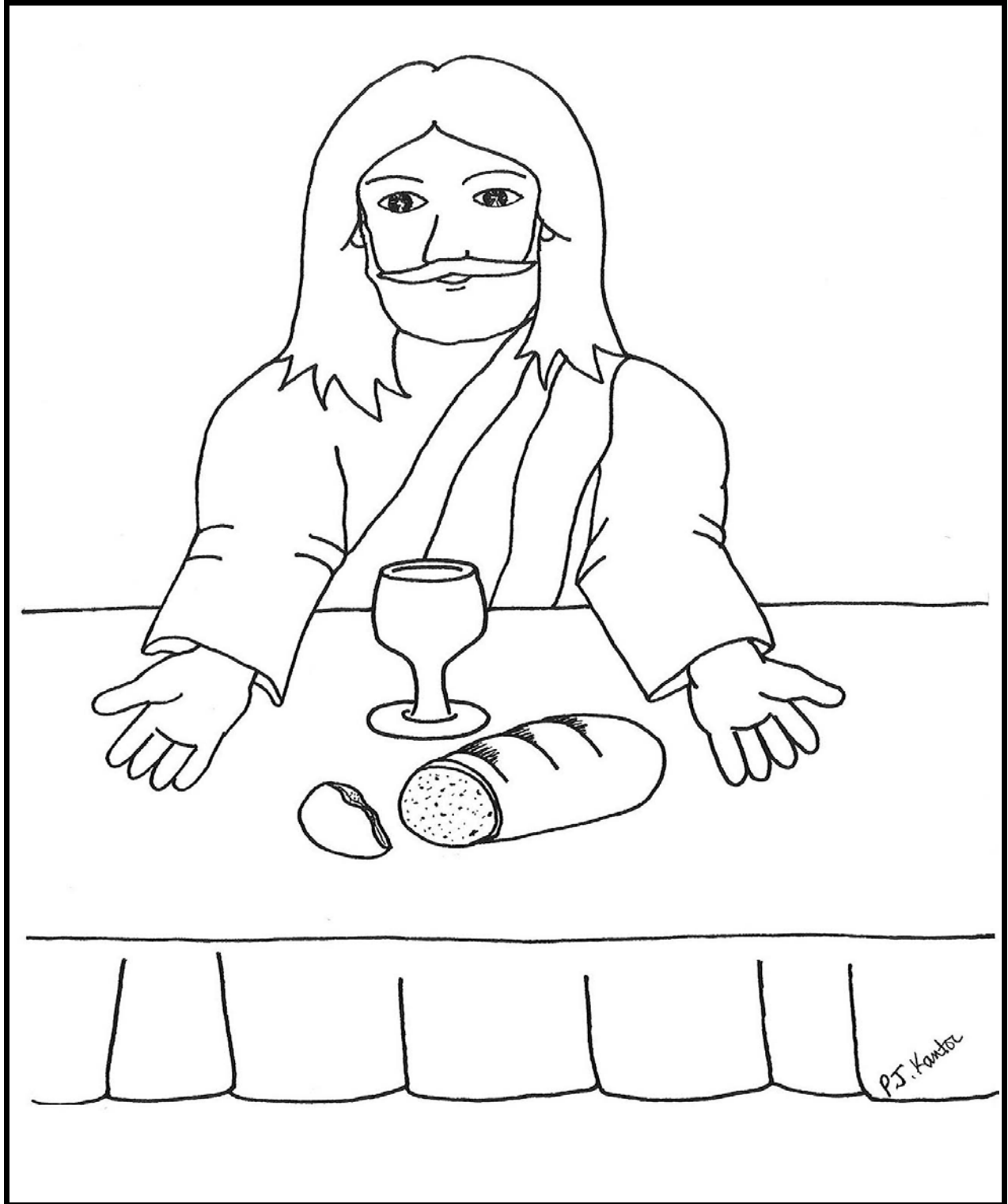


Remember Jesus



I Corinthians 11:23-25, "Jesus said, Remember Me."

Dear Parent,

Thank you for giving us the opportunity to teach your child. Today we talked about how Jesus gave His friends pictures to help them remember Him after He died on the cross and went to heaven. The bread was like a picture of His body that took all the hurts of all the people. The special juice was like a picture of His blood. When Jesus died on the cross, He took all the hurts and all the bad things that people did with Him. When Jesus went back to heaven with His blood, God forgave the bad things people did. We can use Jesus' pictures to help us remember that we can be healed and forgiven.

Goal:

Each child will know that Jesus gave us a way to remember what He did for us.

Scripture:

I Corinthians 11:23-25, Jesus said, "Remember Me."

Song:

Remember Jesus, sung to the tune of **Jesus Loves Me**

Jesus said, "Remember Me.
On the cross I'll die for thee
I'll take sins and sickness, too
All these things away from you."
Je sus won't stay dead

Open hands wide and point to self.
Close eyes and place head in hands

Point to children
Shake head no as you lay head in

Shake head yes

Place hands across chest

Activity Suggestion at Home:

Look at family pictures and talk to your child about how they help you remember people that don't live in your household, things the child did when he/she was little, etc. Sing today's song to help you remember why Jesus died on the cross for us. Have a family communion and talk about remembering Jesus.

Little children learn through simplicity and repetition. For this reason, we have provided you with the picture on the reverse side of this paper and the words to today's song. We encourage you to use the Bible verse, song, and the picture as a daily reminder of the lesson taught today.
