Dear Parent,

Thank you for giving us the opportunity to teach your child. Today we talked about how Jesus went to Heaven just like He said He would! When His friends went to visit the tomb where His body was placed, they were met by an angel instead. The tomb was empty! The angel told them that Jesus went back to Heaven, just like He said he would.

Goal:

Each child should know that Jesus' body did not stay in the tomb but Jesus rose again just as He promised.

Scripture:

Hebrews 7:24, "Jesus lives forever."

Song:

Jesus Lives, sung to the tune of **Jingle Bells**

Jesus lives, Jesus lives

Jesus lives today

They put His body in a tomb but

There He didn't stay

Lay head on hands

Shake finger and head, "no"

He's alive, He's alive

He's no longer dead

Rose again in three short days

Jesus did just like He said!

Point finger up

Shake finger and head, "no"

Hold up three fingers

Nod head

Activity Suggestion at Home:

Play hide and seek with your child. Explain to the child that when you can't find them in one place, it means they are in another place. The women couldn't find Jesus in the tomb because He was in another place. Talk about what living in Heaven must be like. Sing the song together and praise God that Jesus is still alive.

Young children learn through simplicity and repetition. For this reason, we have provided you with the picture on the reverse side of this letter and the words to today's song. We encourage you to use the picture, Bible verse, and song as a daily reminder of the lesson taught today.
