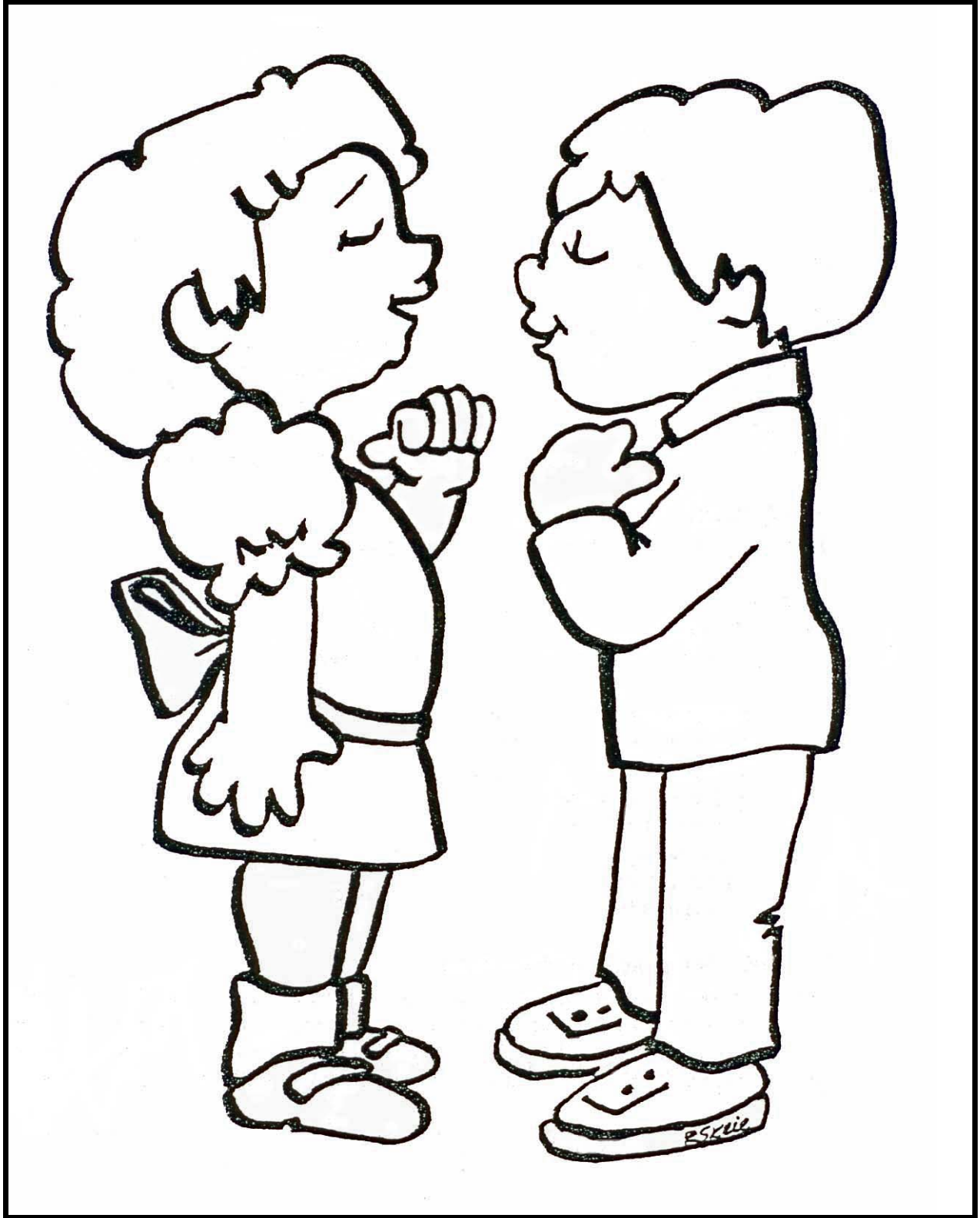


God Made Me Special

Activity Suggestion at Home:

Find items around the house and help your child determine what senses they use to enjoy that item. Does it smell good? Does it make noise? Find different items that the child can touch and feel the differences between the items. At mealtime, talk about the different tastes between the food items. Talk about siblings that might have the same color eyes and friends that may have different color hair. Celebrate how beautiful God made each one of us. Take special time each day to thank God and talk to Him about how wonderfully your child was created.
