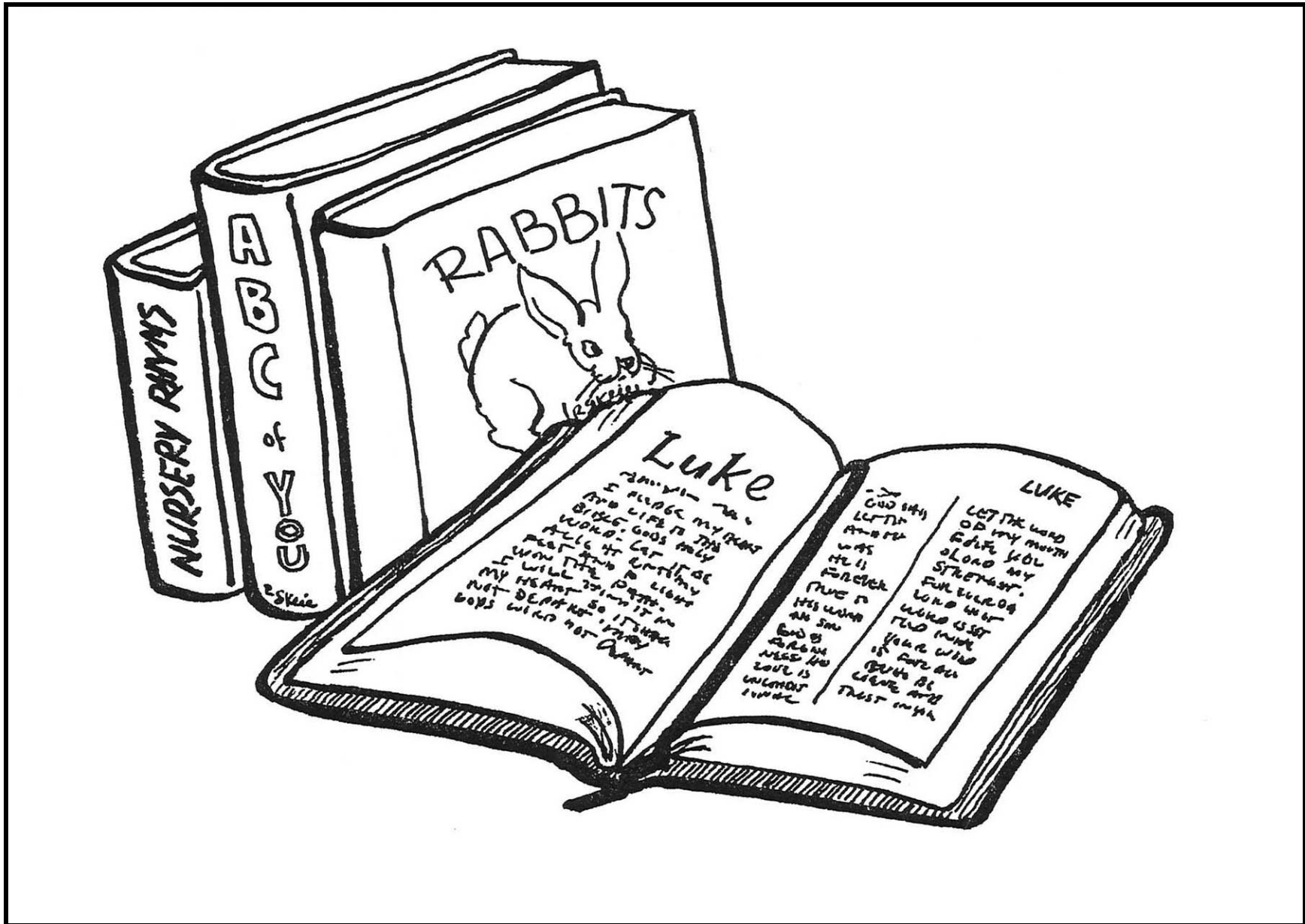


The Bible is a Special Book
